



### REQUIREMENTS FOR IMPORTATION DOGS & CATS TO KINGDOM OF BAHRAIN

1. Dogs and Cats must be more than 3 months old.
2. All cats and dogs must carry microchip number.
3. The animal should have been vaccinated not less than 1 month and not more than 10 months prior to importation. Proof of all vaccinations must be provided in a vaccination booklet.
4. Dogs must have all of the following vaccinations:
  - a. Rabies
  - b. Canine Distemper
  - c. Parvo
  - d. Leptospira
  - E. Hepatitis
5. The puppy must have had 2 doses of all vaccinations and shipped not less than 4 weeks after the 2nd dose.
6. Cats must have the following vaccinations:
  - a. Rabies
  - b. Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis ( cat flu ).
  - c. Feline Caliciviras
  - d. Feline Panleucopenis ( cat enteritis ).
7. Kitten must have had 2 doses of all vaccinations and shipped not less than 4 weeks after the 2nd dose.
8. Rabies neutralizing antibody Titre Test (RNATT) is required from official laboratory / or from private laboratory and approved by official Veterinarian.
9. All pets must be transported in safe and comfortable cages or boxes with name and address of the owner attached.

10. Before shipping the animal, the owner must obtain an import permit from the Bahrain Veterinary Quarantine. To obtain the permit, which is valid for 30 days, the owner must submit a copy of all necessary documents including vaccination records.

11. The maintenance of the animal during quarantine period shall remain the responsibility of the owner.
